Adecco Holds Practise Job Interviews at Taylor's Business School, Subang Jaya

Consultants from Adecco attended Taylor's Business School to hold mock – or practise - interviews, in order to familiarize students to the real experience of attending job interviews once they graduate. The event was organized by AIESEC and Taylor's College, whose objective was to provide preparation and exposure to the students before they venture out into their careers.

Students from all levels attended – ranging from first year to final year. They were attentive and eager to learn and improve. Interviews were conducted in separate rooms, and each student was required to submit their resume. There was a selection of jobs to choose from, based on vacancies from well-known companies, and students were interviewed based on the jobs that they were applying for.

Students were questioned about knowledge of their field of study and how they could fit into the role based on their strengths and interests, how much knowledge they had regarding the job role, along with areas of specific interest. Evaluation was based upon communication skills, knowledge, appearance and personality.

Adecco consultants gave genuine feedback on areas that the students needed to improve upon, and on a positive note, the general opinion about Taylor's students were that they communicate well, have a good grasp of the English language, dressed appropriately for the interview, and demonstrated sound knowledge of study, work and areas of interest.
